- Children between the ages of 3-15 years
- Have an Autism Spectrum Disorder diagnosis from a physician or psychiatrist

What do Services Look Like?

- Families are granted 180 hours per year of focused Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy and caregiver training.
- A treatment Plan will be written for your child based on the concerns the caregiver would like to see addressed in therapy.
- If applicable, each family is responsible for paying a cost share that is based off their family size and income.
